Workshop phases, booking & fees

Workshop phases

A week long workshop takes place once a day Monday to Friday (between 90 and 135 minutes per session), Intensive weekend workshops take place twice a day (between 135 and 180 minutes per session), sometimes in a longer block (360 minutes) once a day. Extra long workshops have a duration of more than 150 minutes (exception: Intensive weekend workshops = more than 180 minutes). A list of extra long workshops will be available as of 10th April. Co-taught workshops are held by at least two teachers and have an additional charge.

Booking

Booking workshops will be possible as of 10th April 2019, this is also when our Workshop Office at MuseumsQuartier opens, Mon–Fri 16:30–18:30 (except on holidays). From 6th June to 5th July it will be open Mon–Fri 12:00–19:00. From 8th July on the Workshop Office will be located at Arsenal with opening hours Mon 8:30–19:00 and Tue–Sun von 8:45–19:00. Workshop phases, booking & fees

Booking & Payment

A workshop will be booked for you upon the receipt of at least the first workshop fee and bind you to pay for remaining fees if you book more than one workshop. The booking will be confirmed via e-mail. Please pay the remaining fee(s) ideally one week before the first workshop starts in order to avoid the usually heavy office traffic at the Workshop Office on the first day of each phase. If you want to attend a workshop spontaneously you are welcome to book directly at the Workshop Office.

Should we receive registrations for workshops that are already fully booked, we will offer you alternatives and refund the entire workshop fee, should the alternative not appeal to you.

• Online booking

As of 10 April you can book workshops on our website. You can pay with Visa, MasterCard, DinersClub or direct banking (secure online clearing via encrypted SSL-connection) via a link. This link is also provided when you book the workshop of your choice. If you do not have an ImPulsTanz account yet, you will be able to register through the provided payment link. Please use your email-address as your username.

• Payment via bank transfer

The last day for the payment via bank transfer is 14 days before the beginning of your (first) workshop. Please note that a bank transfer usually takes a few days.

Workshop phases, booking & fees

- Booking by letter or fax

Please send a letter to our festival office (ImPulsTanz, Museumstraße 5/21, 1070 Vienna, Austria) or fax your booking to +43.1.526 52 57-55. Please state clearly your name, address, phone number, the teacher's name(s), workshop title(s), workshop phase/date and level. Please keep in mind, that you have to pay at least the first workshop fee, in order to secure the booking.

Attention:

- Reservations via e-mail or phone are not possible!
- Remaining workshop fees have to be paid before the workshops start. Ideally you pay latest a week before the first workshop starts in order to be able to use the Fast Lane at the Workshop Office, provided for those, who only need to pick up their workshop pass.
- Please bring the documents required for reduced workshop fees to verify the professional status and / or your ID to verify your age.

Cancellation policy and fee

Cancellations from your side can only be accepted up to 14 days before the first workshop starts. Please note that we charge 50 euro cancellation fee. If you cancel later, the workshop fee(s) will not be refunded or will be demanded, even if you can not participate in the workshops. We recommend therefore to cancel on time!

Workshop pass and photo

In order to avoid long wait when you pick up your workshop pass we kindly ask you to upload an image with your online-registration directly into your ImPulsTanz account. You can also send us a digital portrait (JPG / JPEG or GIF with the size of 300×400 pixels) via e-mail. Please take notice of our Fast Lane at the Workshop Office for everyone, who only needs to pick up the workshop pass (meaning: for everyone who does not need to pay remaining fees or requires changes).

As soon as you receive a payment confirmation from the Workshop Office and have sent a digital portrait (photo) you can pick up the workshop pass at the Workshop Office, even before the opening day of the festival!

The workshop pass applies as your ticket, therefore we kindly ask you to bring it along to class and show it to our staff before and after the workshop.

Workshop phases, booking & fees

Verification for reduced fees

Reduced fee

The reduced fee applies to students and to Golden Age participants.

Reduced fees apply for students and apprentices until the completion of their 27th year of life (born after 10th August 1993) for all ImPulsTanz workshops 2019.

There are reductions for dance enthusiasts of 55 years and older for all ImPulsTanz workshops 2019.

Reduced fee for professionals

The reduced fee for professionals applies for professional dancers and active dance teachers.

These reduced fees are granted to full time engaged / freelance (Contemporary, HipHop, Modern, Jazz, Ballet) dancers, choreographers and dance students attending an internationally acknowledged full time dance school (in the last two years of a four year programme and the last year of a three year programme). This reduction is a support for decidedly professional ambitions of young dancers on their path to an artistic stage career. To be accepted for this price reduction we ask you to bring material that documents clearly your full-time involvement in dance (engagement contracts, certificates etc.) not older than two years. Please send these documents via e-mail or bring them latest when you pick up your workshop pass at the Workshop Office. Participants not accepted as professional dancers will be charged the regular workshop fees.

Reduced fees for all workshops are granted to active dance teachers upon proof of their teacher status. The teacher status is granted for active dance teachers only to support their further education and is valid for one calendar year. To be accepted for this price reduction we ask you to provide material that documents clearly your active and continuous teaching activity in the last two years (folders, flyers, links, contracts with dance schools). Please send these documents via e-mail or bring them latest when you pick up your workshop pass at the Workshop Office. Participants not accepted as active dance teachers will be charged the regular workshop fees.

Reduced fee for groups

If you are a group of 10 or more dancers (professionals, amateurs or beginners), we will happily grant you the multi-booking discount: The price of the second workshop for either professionals or youth (depending on the age of participants). If you are interested, please contact the Workshop Office.

Reduced fee for youth

The youth fee applies to all teenagers up to 18 years of age (born 2001 or later) for all ImPulsTanz Workshops 2019 (except SHAKE THE BREAK workshops).

Research Projects

The ImPulsTanz Research Department offers a series of Research Projects for professional dancers giving the opportunity to work together in small and personal groups. The participants are selected by the artists, who are running the Research Projects, based on the application documents. The working process focuses on the interaction between the docents and the students. So far, artists like Merce Cunningham (New York), Emio Greco | PC (Amsterdam), Wendy Houston (London), Akram Khan (London), Vera Mantero (Lisbon), Mathilde Monnier (Paris), Lloyd Newson (London), Steve Paxton (Vermont), Thomas Hauert (Brussels), Meg Stuart (Berlin/Brussels), Mark Tompkins (Paris) Wim Vandekeybus (Brüssel), Jennifer Lacey (Paris), Philipp Gehamcher (Wien), Ian Kaler (Berlin) as well as Maria F. Scaroni (Berlin) acted as mentors of Research Projects. www.impulstanz.com/en/research

danceWEB Scholarship Programme

danceWEB is a five-week advanced programme for contemporary dancers, which takes place during the festival. The programme offers the chance to get in contact with other artists by attending the extensive workshop programme and the Research Projects to about 50 aspiring choreographers from approximately 40 countries.

2019 the scholars will be accompanied by artistic mentors Anne Juren and Annie Dorsen in dialogue with Mette Ingvarsen.

ATLAS - create your dance trails

ATLAS - create your dance trails is a module-based training programme embedded in the ImPulsTanz - Vienna International Dance Festival. It offers a dynamic environment that allows young dance artists with first choreographic experience to intensively work on their professional development. The programme is designed to address two of the most basic needs of emerging choreographers: access to studio space for research and creation as well as continued inspiration through top-class training possibilities, a broad range of international dance productions and the exchange with fellow artists from more than 100 countries as well as of course the peer-to-peer exchange within the group. On top, weekly showings give a chance to present works or work steps to an international audience.

An experienced ATLAS Buddy will advise the participants in the process of composing their individual programme, while an ATLAS Coach will accompany the participants' works dramaturgically during their stay. ATLAS Coach 2019 is the dance dramaturge Guy Cools. Previous performance fragments may but don't need to be included in this process.

Symposium
